About the University:

The College of Agriculture, Junagadh started functioning in the month of June, 1960. The college was affiliated to Gujarat University, Ahmedabad from its inception till the year 1967. Subsequently, on inception of Saurashtra University in 1968 at Rajkot, the affiliation was transferred to it. The Gujarat Agricultural University was established in February 1972 with the State-wide mandate for the triple function of Agricultural Education, Research and Extension Education. For strengthening of these activities at regional level, the Gujarat Agricultural University is separated in to four different Agricultural Universities in the State by Gujarat Agricultural University Act-2004. Junagadh Agricultural University is one of them, which came in to existence from 1st May, 2004. The College of Agriculture was established in 1960. There are seven multidisciplinary Main Research Stations, five Main Research Stations for various crops and eleven sub Research Stations/Testing Centres in the University for the Development of new varieties/hybrids of crops, vegetables and fruits. These centres also work for the development of economical and sustainable production technology packages for newly developed varieties/hybrids with its modification every year. The first hybrid bajra and hybrid castor were developed by scientists of this university. The extension component includes seven Krushi Vigyan Kendras (Jamnagar, Amreli, Targhadia, Khapat, Nana Kandhasar, Pipalia and Morbi), one Sardar Smruti Kendra (Junagadh), Centre of Excellence of Training in Groundnut, Centre of Excellence on Soil-Water Management and a T & V scheme.

About the organizing Department:

Junagadh Agricultural University (JAU) is one of the leading State Agricultural Universities in India established in 2004 as a separate University from the erstwhile Gujarat Agricultural University. The Department of Agricultural Extension, College of Agriculture, JAU, Junagadh was established in 1960 and the PG programme is being offered at the Department from 1968. A total 34 number of students had obtained Doctorate and 138 students had obtained Master's degree. The department renders the services of teaching in the faculty of Agriculture and Horticulture. The major area of research include adoption of agril. Technology, impact assessment of technology, training needs of stake holder, socio-economic condition of farmers, technological gap, extension management and indigenous technology etc. 37 number of departmental research project were taken up and respective findings were implemented for the betterment of livelihood.

About NAHEP:

NAHEP has been formulated by ICAR with a total cost of US\$ 165 million (Rupees 1100 crores at the exchange rate of Rs. 66.75 = 1US\$) for five years starting from 2017-18. The project is proposed on 50:50 cost sharing basis between the World Bank and the Government of India, implemented at the Education Division, ICAR, New Delhi. Overall, the project aims to develop resources and mechanism for supporting infrastructure, faculty and student advancement, and providing means for bettergovernance and management of Agricultural Universities, so that a holistic model can be developed to raise the standard of current agricultural education system that provides more jobs and is entrepreneurship oriented and on par with the global agriculture education standards.

About the training programme:

This training programme will be conducted under the aegis NAHEP-IDP, a project being operated at the University funded by ICAR, New Delhi for improving the overall competency of the undergraduate students of the University. It also helps the students for exposure of new generation extension tools and techniques for strengthening the existing the capabilities of the students. Accordingly, the specific objectives of the intended training programme are as follows :

- 1. To enhance capacities of agricultural extension and advisory service providers by using next generation extension tools and techniques for transfer of technology techniques.
- 2. To unlock potential within their teams and enable the organization to deliver its strategic objectives with framework for planning personal development activities and embedding students' new skills and knowledge.
- 3. To reflect the students about the impact assessment, new age mobile application, ICT tools and intervention, and online learning tools for future extension strategies.
